

SHINY SHRUG



Size: 10/12 (14/16) UK **Size:** 6/8 (10/12) USA **Size:** 36/38 (40/42) EU

NOTE: Figures in brackets () refer to larger size. Where only one figure is given this refers to both sizes.

Skill Level: easy

How much yarn: g 100 (125) of New Glitter yarn,

deep blue shade no. 8589

Needles: Pair of 3.25 mm (no. 10) knitting needles

Hook: A 3.00 mm (no. 11) crochet hook

Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point

STITCHES

Using needles: stocking stitch (st st)

Using crochet hook: chain (chain) - Slip stitch (ss)

Double crochet (dc) - Treble (tr)

TENSION

24 sts and 30 rows measure 10 cm square over stocking st with 3.25 mm (no. 10) needles and double stranded yarn.

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: worked in on piece, starting from right sleeve and ending with left sleeve.

With 3.25 mm (no. 10) needles and yarn held double throughout cast on 60 (70) sts. Work in st st, inc 1 st at each end every 6th row 10 (12) times. There are 80 (94) sts. When work measures 24 (25) cm from beg, shape Front opening-and-neck, dec 1 st on RH (right hand) side, inside 2 sts, on next and every other row 18 (20) times: 62 (74) sts remain. Work other 60 (72) rows straight, then inc 1 st on RH side, inside 2 sts, on next and every other row 18 (20) times: there are 80 (94) sts. Cont to work for sleeve, dec 1 st at each end every 6th row 10 (12) times. When sleeve measures 24 (25) cm, cast off rem 60 (70) sts.

FINISHING

Fold in half shrug along all length, from a sleeve to other sleeve. With yarn needle, sew sleeve seams. With crochet

hook and yarn held double throughout work around each cuff as follows: 1st round: starting from side seam, work a round of dc all around, ending with a ss into 1st dc. (If it is possible, it is required a number of sts multiple of 8). 2nd round: 1 dc into same place as last ss, * ch 6, skip 3 dc, 1 dc into next dc; rep from * ending with ch 3 and 1 tr into 1st dc to create last arch. 3rd round: 1 dc into arch just made, 8 tr into next arch, * 1 dc into next arch, 8 tr into following arch; rep from * ending with a ss into 1st dc. Fasten off. With crochet hook and yarn held double throughout work around all shrug opening (front neck and back lower border) as follows: 1st round: work a round of dc all around, ending with a ss into 1st dc. (If it is possible, it is required a number of sts multiple of 6). 2nd round: 1 dc into same place as last ss, * ch 6, skip 2 dc, 1 dc into next dc; rep from * ending with ch 3 and 1 tr into 1st dc to create last arch. 3rd round: 1 dc into arch just made, * ch 6, 1 dc into next arch; rep from * ending with ch 3 and 1 tr into 1st dc to create last arch. 4th round: as 3rd round. 5th round: 1 dc into arch just made, 8 tr into next arch, * 1 dc into next arch, 8 tr into following arch; rep from * ending with a ss into 1st dc. Fasten off.
